Please PRINT and READ this entire letter for important league information and rules

Welcome to the TripleEDGE 2010 Summer League. If your name appears on a web roster you have a confirmed spot in the league. We are looking forward to a great season of lacrosse.

SCHEDULES and ROSTERS: The division rosters, first week's schedules, and directions to game sites are posted on our website at www.TripleEDGEIax.com Review your schedule very closely.

TripleEDGE sponsors only game sessions—NO practices - if a team chooses to practice the players do so at their own risk.

ONLY REGISTERED PLAYERS MAY PARTICIPATE IN LEAGUE PLAY - NO EXCEPTIONS

This is not only a serious liability issue it is not fair to those who have registered and paid to play

ALL games will feature certified officials. ALL players are guaranteed quality playing time. ALL teams will be supervised by adult coaches and TripleEDGE field supervisors. Our field staff will be wearing clearly identifiable staff shirts. If you EVER have any comments or concerns, PLEASE speak to a TripleEDGE staff member!

- It is very important that you arrive at least 30 MINUTES EARLY for your first game.
- You will receive your game jersey a check-in at the first game you attend. Throughout the season, PLEASE check-in at least 15 minutes before your scheduled game times. BE DRESSED and READY TO PLAY 10 minutes prior to game time-- Game clock starts at scheduled game time.
- Check-in: All players MUST check-in at the TripleEDGE tent 15 minutes prior to EVERY game.
- **PHOTO ID** - ALL VARSITY and JV players only MUST present a photo ID card at check-in prior to EVERY GAME - a valid driver's license, school ID, walkers ID, or a passport - a birth certificate is acceptable for the first game only. **NO EXCEPTIONS - NO ID - YOU CANNOT PLAY**
- **Equipment:** All Players must provide and wear their own equipment. (see details in the rules below) TripleEDGE DOES NOT rent equipment for league play We do provide goalie equipment on every field.

Referees and field staff will not allow you to play without all of the proper equipment.

- **Jerseys:** You will be issued a TripleEDGE team jersey which is yours to keep. Players MUST wear their issued jersey during all games.
Don't forget your jersey - We will not provide extra jerseys - you cannot play without your TripleEDGE jersey
- **Shoes:** Players may wear cleats and or tennis/basketball shoes at ALL game sites.
- **Water:** Players should bring their own water and ice in a plastic water bottle.
- **Spectators:** SAFETY FIRST - **Some game site entrances are behind the game goals. Wait for a stop in the action BEFORE entering or leaving a game site or crossing behind goals.** Family and friends are welcome to attend games. Please be very careful and alert when entering any game sites. Spectators are required to sit on the sideline across from the team benches and at least 5 yards from the sideline. We encourage you to cheer and support your team. We expect all spectators to exhibit good sportsmanship at all times. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Balance Due Any outstanding league fees must be paid at the field prior to the player's first game.

All fees not received prior to the early registration deadline do not qualify for the \$35 early registration discount - balance due is \$185 - No Exceptions. Payment must be made at the check-in prior to the first game - cash or checks only - credit card payment will not be accepted on the field.

TripleEDGE Lacrosse League Rules and Refund Policy

Players and Parents read these rules very carefully - All players who step on the field to play acknowledge that they have read, understand, and agree to abide by these rules and understand and accept the consequences of violating them.

TripleEDGE "game only" leagues provide players the opportunity to sharpen their game skills in a competitive, organized, and safe environment. We expect all players to play by the rules and display the same high level of self discipline and sportsmanship they would during the regular spring season.

All Games are two 25 minute running halves - game clock will start at the scheduled start time. Halftime is a maximum 2 minute break. EXCEPTION: Last minute of the game will be start/stop if there is a differential of two goals or less. Games must start and end on time.

- **COACHES:** We welcome volunteer coaches who know the players. We have qualified staff at every field that will help the volunteer coaches and/or coach any team without a volunteer. **ALL volunteer coaches must review, agree to, and sign a Volunteer Coach Agreement prior to joining a team on the field.** A maximum of THREE registered volunteer coaches are permitted in the bench area - no exceptions. Violations of the Coach Agreement may result in dismissal of the volunteer coach. EQUAL PLAYING TIME IS A PRIORITY
- **RULES:** Are the same as regular SPRING season - NFHS with the exception of game time. Youth divisions will play modified NFHS rules (NVYLL). Division specific rules will be reviewed before the first game.
- **FIGHTING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!!** Relax, take a deep breath, and walk away. If you START a fight or RETALIATE you will BE EJECTED FROM THE LEAGUE -- NO WARNINGS, WITH NO REFUNDS - at the discretion of game officials and the TripleEDGE field staff.
- **UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT:** Taunting, Cursing, or Disrespect by any players, coaches, spectators directed toward other players, coaches, or game officials will not be tolerated. Penalties range from a 1-3 minute non releasable penalty to ejection from a game and/or the league. If you are ejected from a game you CANNOT play in the next game. Disciplinary action is at the discretion of game officials and TripleEDGE field staff.
- Personal Foul penalty time is start/stop on the whistle.
- **TIME OUTS:** One 30 second time out per game - game clock stops.
- **GOALIES:** **All high school teams MUST have someone play goalie - we will not use "Hector the Rejector" for high school games.** We will have goalie equipment at all fields and ALL players should wear a protective cup. A team at any age may borrow a registered goalie from another team in the league. "Hectors" may be used in the youth divisions only. If a team chooses to play with a "Hector" the game will be played. However, it will be ruled a forfeit with the win going to the opposing team.
- **FACE-OFFS (boys) / Draws (girls).** There will be a Face-off / Draw to begin each half and after each goal. (Youth Divisions: "Mercy Rule" team losing by 5 goals takes the ball at midfield)
- **SUBSTITUTIONS:** All subs are on the fly - there will be NO HORN on out-of-bounds plays.
- **TIE GAMES:** Time permitting only - If a game is tied at the end of regulation we will play a 1 minute over time period- If time does not permit the team who SCORED FIRST will be declared the winner.
- **EQUIPMENT** All personal equipment rules are in effect for the League, including a **MOUTHPIECE**, legal stick, a NOCSAE approved helmet with 4-point chinstrap, shoulder pads, arm pads (goalies according to age group options) and gloves. Check your equipment BEFORE you leave for your games.

Girls A MOUTHPIECE, mandatory protective eyewear, and a legal stick.

Referees and TripleEDGE Field staff WILL NOT ALLOW YOU TO PLAY without the proper equipment - NO EXCEPTIONS

TripleEDGE REFUND POLICY -

All players and parents agreed to this policy at the time of registration

NO TELEPHONE REFUND REQUESTS WILL BE HONORED For ANY PROGRAMS

We accept **ONLY** written refund requests for all programs.

All requests must be received prior to the participant's first game after the final schedule is published and are subject to a \$35 administration fee. No refunds or pro-rated refunds will be issued once the season begins including but not limited to sickness, injury or inability to participate in the league due to schedule conflicts.
